

Policy on children using the club

Children under the age of 18 are very welcome at Orford House Social Club.

To ensure the club is a safe and enjoyable space for all users, children under the age of 16 must be supervised by an accompanying adult at all times.

Children must be well behaved and considerate of other users of the club.

Children are welcome in the function room and the outdoor areas, until 8pm (unless they are attending a function, when they may remain longer).

Children are not permitted in the members' bar (unless taking part in a supervised bowling event), except if the function room is unavailable, and in any event children are not permitted in the members' bar after 8pm.

Children are not permitted, nor allowed to play snooker or pool, in the snooker room, unless with the prior agreement of a member of the snooker committee.

Except when taking part in a supervised bowling event, children are not permitted onto the bowls green or in the changing rooms at any time.

Children can apply for club membership but are not required to do so.

When there is not enough space to store buggies in the function room they must be put in the hallway, but must never block doorways or thoroughfare. They are left at the owner's own risk.

Any member of staff or Committee member may require a child and any accompanying adults to leave the club if there is a breach of this policy, the code of conduct or the club rules.
